<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The revision will be prepared by a Project Group (PG) composed of: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. A BIML Assistant Director as convener, b. Individuals appointed by CIML Members (with voice and one vote per country), and c. Individuals appointed by Corresponding Member Representatives (with voice but no vote). 2. The BIML will also serve as the secretariat of the PG. 3. The PG will work on a consensus basis as far as possible, but if necessary on matters where there is sustained non-consensus, the PG shall vote according to B 6-1:2019, 5.12. 4. Final Draft revisions of B 6-1 and B 6-2 will be presented to the CIML for approval at the 58th CIML Meeting in October 2023 (Step one – see below). 		
Why should the OIML develop this publication?		
<p>As a high priority publication, B 6-1 and B 6-2 are required to undergo a periodic review two years after approval or reconfirmation. The BIML has conducted a periodic review and is proposing a two-step revision of B 6-1 and B 6-2.</p> <p>Step one will be to revise B 6-1 and B 6-2 to align the publications with current practice and to correct issues that have been identified by the BIML.</p> <p>Step two will entail a more detailed revision of B 6-1 and B 6-2 to address more fundamental issues regarding the OIML technical work processes and procedures, e.g. whether voting should take place on a 1CD and reconsideration of the CIML preliminary ballot and approval process, and to address the outcomes of the work of the OIML Digitalisation Task Group, e.g. requirements for the digitalisation of OIML publications.</p>
