Introduction of candidates for the CEEMS AG Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson

The position of CEEMS AG Vice-Chairperson became vacant when Dr Peter Ulbig left his post at the PTB. The AG invited nominations for this position, and at its meeting in May 2022 recommended that Mr Han Jianping be appointed as Vice-Chairperson.

The retirement of the current Chairperson at the end of 2022 meant that the AG also sought nominations for this position during the year. At its meeting in October 2022, the AG recommended that Mr Jaco Marneweck be appointed as Chairperson.

In both cases, it was decided to apply the procedure in the revised B 19 *Terms of Reference for the Advisory Group on matters concerning Countries and Economies with Emerging Metrology Systems (CEEMS)* (see 57th CIML Meeting agenda item 16.3) , and the AG now recommends that the CIML approves the two appointments. In the case of the Vice-Chairperson, the appointment would be with immediate effect, and in the case of the Chairperson, the appointment would start on 1 January 2023. Both appointments are for a term of three years.



Short CV - Jaco Marneweck



Holds a diploma in Electrical Engineering (Light Current) from TUT (Technical University of Tshwane, South Africa).

Started his career at Iscor (now ArcelorMittal South Africa) in Pretoria in 1986 as Technician in the Instrumentation Department.

In 1987 he joined **the dti** (the Department of Trade and Industry of South Africa) as Inspector in the Trade Metrology Department.

In 1991 this function (Trade Metrology Department) was transferred and became the Legal Metrology Department at the SABS (South African Bureau of Standards) and in 2008 the Legal Metrology Department of the SABS was transferred to form part of the newly established National Regulator for Compulsory Specifications (NRCS).

During his 35 year career within the trade metrology/ legal metrology domain he worked as:

- Inspector (also called trade metrologist or weights and measures officer or assize officer)
- Metrologist in the mass and volume calibration laboratory of the SABS and National Regulator
- Assessor, evaluating the competence of verification/repair laboratories doing verifications on behalf of the National Regulator
- Project Leader for the type approval laboratory evaluating measuring instruments used for a prescribed purpose,
- Manager and later Senior Manager responsible for all Legal Metrology inspection activities countrywide.

Currently holds the position of Senior Manager: Inspections in the Legal Metrology unit of the NRCS.

Currently also the acting General Manager Legal Metrology and therefore CIML member for South Africa, member country representative to SADC MEL (South African Development Community Cooperation in Legal Metrology) and member country representative to AFRIMETS (Intra-Africa Metrology System).

He has held the position of Regional Coordinator (Head of Secretariat) for SADC MEL since 2014 and is the Chairperson for the SADC MEL Technical Committee 1 dealing with the “Sale of goods”.

He has been involved with the Co-secretariat in the activities of AFRIMETS TC Legal Metrology, has represented SADC MEL on AFRIMETS TC Legal Metrology since 2016, and was the Vice-Chairperson of AFRIMETS from 2018 to 2022.

He represents South Africa on OIML (International Organization for Legal Metrology) Technical Committee TC 6 on “Prepackaged Products” as Convener.

Highlights of his career:

Being part of the first ever peer assessments of instrument manufacturers (Sartorius and Mettler) wanting recognition for type approval test results under the OIML MAA (Mutual Acceptance Agreement on type approval test results – measured once, accepted everywhere principle) (now the OIML Certification System).

Represented NRCS Legal Metrology in the development of the “new/ modern” Legal Metrology Act, 2014 and Regulations, 2017 in South Africa based on OIML D1.

In my 35 years within the legal metrology community, I have:

- gathered an understanding of the challenges faced by CEEMS to introduce and operate a legal metrology system;
- gained hands on experience of evaluating needs and developing and implementing legislative requirements for legal metrology in CEEMS;
- gathered vast experience in developing training material and offering training on various types of measuring instruments and prepackages to officials in CEEMS;
- offered consultancy and advisory assistance to many CEEMS countries and their experts during study visits;
- built a good formal/ informal contact base with legal metrology staff in CEEMS; and
- persuaded donors of the importance of legal metrology and convinced them to allocate resources to CEEMS.

If elected to the position of CEEMS AG Chairperson I would:

- support and enable the CEEMS community to actively participate in OIML activities through opportunities of engagement created by OIML such as accessible e-Learning courses developed by technical experts, closer co-operation with OIML RLMO RT to further understand needs of CEEMS within those RLMOs, and creating awareness of the importance and benefits of OIML TC work, etc.
- developing OIML support policies and plans for CEEMS such as the guide to the use of on-line technology for conducting CEEMS activities in a post-COVID world, and
- providing guidance for the OIML’s activities for CEEMS using my vast knowledge and experience in legal metrology and CEEMS.
